CARSAMPAF is an independent contributory body of the CAR/SAM Regional Planning and Execution Group (GREPECAS), and its events are supported by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO); therefore, two duly accredited representatives from each State/Territory will be exempt from any participation fees for this event.

Within the framework of this year's conference, the CARSAMPAF General Assembly is being held to elect members of the new Board of Directors and Technical Support Group, as well as to update the internal operational documents.
